Full Time Watershed Educator Position Available

The Stony Brook-Millstone Watershed Association is seeking an enthusiastic and motivated person with strong knowledge about water and watersheds for its award-winning environmental education program, located on the 950-acre Watershed Reserve in Hopewell Township, New Jersey. The reserve includes a 1,500 square foot Butterfly House, a LEED- Platinum certified building, an organic farm, acres of field and forest, a pond, and a portion of the Stony Brook. Education staff conducts approximately 400 programs annually, reaching 10,000 people. Among these environmental science and ecology-based programs are school field trips addressing the Next Generation Science Standards, children's and family programs for the public, teacher workshops, and a summer environmental education day camp. **Position begins in January 2018; salary commensurate with experience.**

Responsibilities:

- Assist in the development, promotion and teaching of education programs for schools and the general public.
- Assist with the care and maintenance of educational displays, including live animals.
- Interact with visitors to the Watershed Center, addressing inquiries about the natural world and the environment; and promoting the Watershed Association's mission, programs, and activities.
- Help develop, secure and maintain equipment and materials for education programs.
- Assist in daily supervision of interns and volunteers;
- Assist education team on routine facility maintenance, office tasks, and other projects as necessary for the smooth operation of the facility.

General Qualifications:

- Minimum Bachelor's degree in environmental education, education, the life sciences or related majors, or equivalent life experience
- Experience working with children in an outdoor, educational setting
- Strong knowledge of water, watersheds, and natural history
- Experience working with volunteers and/or interns
- Experience designing environmental education programs
- Good organizational skills; ability to multitask
- Excellent communication skills; written, verbal and listening
- Strong interest and enthusiasm for the environment and desire to share it with others, especially children
- Strong spirit of cooperation and teamwork; good sense of humor
- Willingness to learn and participate in various aspects of nature center work
