



How to Submit an e-Comment (Letter) to the FERC PennEast Docket CP20-47

Our goal is to submit as many substantial, fact-based comments as possible. Please submit multiple comments between now and Sept. 2!

1. Click the e-Comment link:

<https://ferconline.ferc.gov/QuickComment.aspx>

2. Enter Your Information

- Include Name, Email address, and phone number (optional).
- Type the characters in the picture into the box provided.
- Click "Authorize".

3. Check Your Email

- Look for the "FERC eComment Request" email.
- Click on the first link in the email to display the "Submit eComment" screen.

4. Enter the Docket Number

- Enter **CP20-47**, the new PennEast pipeline docket number.
 - Click "Search".
 - After a moment, the PennEast Application will appear in the search results.
- Click the blue "+" button to add it to your "Selected Dockets".

5. Enter Your Comments

- Enter your comments, or Copy and Paste your comments from a Word or text document.

6. Send Your Comments

- Simply click the "Submit" button and your comments will be sent to FERC.

In your comments you can say:

- FERC should treat PennEast's proposal as a new project, not an amendment to an existing (expired) certificate.
- PennEast has not proven there is a need for the Phase I portion of the project. They only have Shippers for 50% of the capacity of the pipeline and *have not revealed who has signed those contracts*.
- FERC needs to make all new phase one shipping contract information public and not hide it behind privileged information.
- PennEast's attempt to amend its certificate in this manner is a glaring subversion of the Natural Gas Act.
- Extend the comment period an additional 30 days
